I usually went with friends from my home church, but we quickly connected with others from different places. We still keep in touch with each other, and it's a wonderful gift to have those relationships that have lasted for so long. I even went back a few years after I graduated and served as a counselor!

My mom says that I probably wouldn't have responded to God's call on my life to serve in pastoral ministry if it weren't for my time at camp. (I think she's probably right!) I'd come home so excited for the next year and energized about my faith in Jesus Christ. There was something so special and important about taking time away to be in God's creation without other distractions, have fun, worship, reflect on God's love, and think about how I could serve God in my everyday life.

I see the same thing happen as Ana and Luka go to camp each summer - and as many of our kids and youth experience Christian camp. I'm grateful that we pray for them and support them financially. Camp is a part of Christian education and spiritual formation. It's a part of how we fulfill the vows that we make at baptism - to nurture children in faith in Jesus Christ.

Camp certainly can't replace weekly Christian education opportunities, but it does offer intentional time to be formed and transformed. Spending extended time with others in a safe and nurturing environment where the focus is on learning and growing in faith is a gift, and it makes a big difference in our lives. It helps us grow closer to God. It helps us claim God's call on our

lives to serve others in Jesus' name. Many of us who serve in the church - whether as ordained pastors or active laypersons - have been encouraged through Christian camps.

So, I want to thank you for your support of campers of all ages at Lake Harbor UMC. We see the fruit of camping ministry clearly. What a blessing!

Scripture: Genesis 28: 10-19a

Synopsis: Jacob's dream is a welcome relief in the midst of his family drama. He receives a pledge of God's presence and protection. He marks the place as a way to remember God's faithfulness and grace in his life. How do "God moments" stay with us and help us on our faith journey?

August 20, 2017: "In the Beginning: *Marked by Struggle*"

Scripture: Genesis 32: 22-31

Synopsis: Jacob's wrestling match leaves a mark that stays with him. It is a sign of struggle and new life. How do the dips and valleys in our life with God remind us of God's steadfast presence?

August 27, 2017: "In the Beginning: *The Power of Jealousy*"

Scripture: Genesis 37: 1-4, 12-28

Synopsis: Sibling rivalry is a reality for Joseph and his brothers, and Jacob's special treatment adds to the problem. Where do we struggle with jealousy, and how do we keep it in check so that we don't act on it in ways that harm one another?
