**SCRIPTURE REFERENCE:** Matthew 27:11-26

**CHURCH YEAR SEASON:** Easter

**SUGGESTED USE:** Sermon Illustration, Sermon Starter

**CHARACTERS:** 

MEL - a former leper DAN, SARAH, LISA - members of the crowd Other CROWD members (if possible)

PROPS: None

**COSTUMES:** Biblical or modern

**SOUND:** Four wireless microphones

**LIGHTING:** General stage

**SETTING:** Pilate's courtyard

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The crowd enters, chanting over and over, "Crucify him!" DAN, SARAH, and LISA are in front. MEL casually walks on, notices the commotion, and stands by DAN.

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

MEL: Hey, guys, what's going on?

**DAN:** There's going to be a crucifixion!

**MEL:** Really? Today?

LISA: Yeah, if we can get that lousy governor to listen to us. Crucify him!

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

**MEL:** Oh boy, a crucifixion. Nothing like one of those to pick you up at the end of the

week.

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

LISA: What's taking him so long? He's got an angry mob, and we're all in agreement on

this one.

**DAN:** Lousy Imperial politics. If he was duly elected by the masses, he'd have him half

way to Golgotha.

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

MEL: Yeah, yeah, crucify him!

**SARAH:** And hurry it along! The Sabbath starts at six.

**DAN:** I didn't think about that.

**SARAH:** He's going to filibuster, and we're going to miss out on the fun.

**MEL:** Oh they'll crucify someone else next week.

DAN: We only get to Jerusalem once a year for Passover. Our camel leaves at nine Sun-

day morning.

**MEL:** Oh well, we better make this guy listen up then, right? Crucify him!

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

**LISA:** And whip him with the 39 lashes, just for good measure!



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Everyone looks at LISA.

**DAN:** Oh this is ridiculous. The guy's been found guilty once already by the Sanhedrin.

**SARAH:** You know those Romans. They have to do it their way, with their laws.

**DAN:** Insurrection is against the law of Rome, right?

**MEL:** Last time I checked it was.

**DAN:** Then give him what's coming to him!

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

**MEL:** By the way, who are we crucifying?

**DAN:** Jesus of Nazareth.

MEL: I'm sorry. Did you say Jesus of Nazareth?

SARAH: Yes he did. That Charlatan!

**LISA:** Heretic!

**DAN:** Blasphemer!

CROWD: Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

**DAN:** What's the matter, buddy?

**MEL:** I dunno. It's just, Jesus of Nazareth, he's the reason I'm here today.

**LISA:** He's the reason we're all here. Crucify him!

**CROWD:** Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!

**MEL:** No, no, I don't mean here in the plaza. I mean here on Earth, alive and well.

**DAN:** You don't honestly believe all that son of God talk do you?

**MEL:** I dunno about that. All I know is six months ago my limbs were in danger of fall-
